**Grace Place-**Teaches literacy, language and life skills to children and families at-risk in Golden Gate. Over 95% of the families we serve live at-or-near the federal poverty level. Grace Place provides the helping hand, educational classes, and the personal mentoring that makes a difference. Over 800 individuals (from babies to school students to adults) are enrolled in classes each week at Grace Place. Over 220 volunteer make this work possible and all are welcome to join us!
